



**American Consulate General, Amsterdam, The Netherlands**  
**Medical Appointment Instructions**



In accordance with U.S. law and regulations all immigrant visa applicants are required to undergo a medical examination.

Except as noted below the medical examination includes a chest X-ray photograph, HIV test, and a full physical examination. The panel physician will also check vaccination records and administer vaccinations when required.

In case of applicant's pregnancy the requirement for the X-ray photograph may be waived upon presentation to the panel physician of a statement in English from the applicant's physician or midwife confirming pregnancy

**Both the appointment for the physical examination and for the X-ray photograph should be scheduled and take place on the same date, and AT LEAST ONE (1) week BEFORE your interview at the Consulate.**

**FIRST call the panel physician.**

**Telephone hours for scheduling examination appointments are between 08:30 and 13:00 hours, Monday to Friday.**

**FEES:** Adults: €155.00  
 Children under 15 years of age: €95.00

These above fees are to be paid to the panel physician in cash and in euro only.

Please note that any costs for vaccinations that must be administered are **NOT** included in the above prices.

**Applicants fifteen (15) years of age and older must also have a chest X-ray photograph taken.**

Applicants under 15 are exempt from the X-ray photograph requirement and the HIV test requirement.

After making the appointment for your physical exam please call the below clinic between 09:00 and 17:00 hours, Monday through Friday, for an appointment to have your Chest X-ray picture taken. Advise the clinic of the date of your medical exam by the panel physician.

Fee for the chest X-ray picture is €50. This fee is to be paid to the chest X-ray technician in cash and in euro only.  
**Bring your passport passport for identification.**

**The doctors reserve time in their busy schedules for you so please be on time! Thank you.**  
**Failure to keep an appointment will delay your immigrant visa issuance.**

**You must bring your your passport and TWO (2) photographs with you to the medical appointment**  
 - See the Photo Instructions sheet for the proper 2"x2" (51x51mm) format details-

**The Panel Physician will deliver the results of your completed examination to the Consulate General.**

**IMPORTANT NOTICE**

A blood test for antibodies to the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) is required as part of your medical examination. HIV is the virus that is the cause and the acquired immune deficiency syndrome (AIDS). AIDS is the name given to a group of illnesses, which may occur in persons infected with HIV. Infection with HIV causes a defect in a person's natural immunity against disease. This defect leaves infected people vulnerable to serious illnesses that would not usually be a threat to anyone whose immune system was intact. This test is not to diagnose AIDS, but to detect antibodies to the virus. If the result is positive, it does NOT necessarily mean that you have AIDS or will get it. The results of your test will be provided to a consular officer. A positive test result will mean that you will not be eligible to receive a visa. A positive test result could also have other local consequences on your day to day activities in this country.
