



American Consulate General, Amsterdam, The Netherlands Medical Appointment Instructions



In accordance with U.S. law and regulations all immigrant visa applicants are required to undergo a medical examination.

As noted below the medical examination includes a chest X-ray photograph, and a full physical examination. The panel physician will also check vaccination records and administer vaccinations when required.

FIRST call the **PANEL PHYSICIAN** to schedule the medical examination appointment date and time.

After completion of the exam by the panel physician, you **MUST IMMEDIATELY** proceed to the X-RAY Clinic.

FEES: Adults: € 145.00
Children under 15 years of age: € 95.00 to be paid to the panel physician, in cash and in euro.

Please note that any costs for vaccinations **that must be administered, are NOT included in the above prices.**

Bring your passport for identification and **TWO (2) photographs** with you to the medical appointment

The doctors reserve time in their busy schedules for you so please **be on time!** Thank you
Failure to keep an appointment will delay your immigrant visa issuance.

Bring your passport for identification!

Applicants fifteen (15) years of age and older must also have a chest X-ray photograph taken.

Applicants under 15 are exempt from the X-ray photograph requirement.

Fee for the chest X-ray picture is € 50. This fee is to be paid to the chest X-ray technician, in cash and in euro.

The Panel Physician will deliver the results of your completed medical examination to the Consulate General.

If you do not speak Dutch or English, please bring an interpreter with you, who speaks YOUR language and Dutch or English.

Note: the interpreter MUST bring his/her passport for identification purposes
