



List of Approved Physicians for Medical Examination for Visa

The Embassy of the United States of America has approved the following physicians for the purpose of medical examinations for visa interviews in Pakistan. The medical examination required as part of the immigrant visa application for the United States, and must be performed by one of the physicians listed in these instructions.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Please take the following documents to the doctor's office at the time of the medical examination:

- Original passport and two photocopies of the first two pages.
- Two photographs signed on the front, with the full name written on the back in BLOCK letters.
- Appointment letter issued by the Consular Section the National Visa Center showing your visa category.
- Documents pertaining any prior medical or surgical history.
- Prescriptions for medicines or injections you are currently using.

All applicants under the age of 14 are typically required to go through a physical examination only. However, in some circumstances the panel physician may require an applicant less than 14 years of age to go through a chest X-ray and blood test for tuberculosis, HIV or other diseases of concern.

Please wear loose clothes and avoid wearing unnecessary jewelry when visiting the panel physician's clinic for the medical examination.

In IR-5 cases, children may not accompany the applicant, regardless of age. Children of IR-5 applicants should not have medical examinations performed unless they are the beneficiaries of their own, separate petitions.

IMPORTANT NOTE

*Flu vaccine is only given during the fall season.

Please take the following documents to the doctor's office when presenting for the medical examination:

- Original Passport along with two photocopies.
- Two Photographs signed on the front and full name written on the back in BLOCK letters.
- Packet 3.5 cover letter issued by the Consular Section or any other documentation issued by the US Embassy or the National Visa Center showing your visa category.
- Documents pertaining your previous medical or surgical history.
- Prescription of medicines or injections you are currently using.

All applicants under the age of 14 are required to go through a physical examination only. However, the panel physician may require an applicant less than 14 years of age to go through a chest X-ray and blood test for HIV or other sexually transmitted disease. Please wear loose clothes and avoid wearing unnecessary jewelry, when visiting the panel physician's clinic for medical examination.

In IR-5 cases, children regardless of age may not accompany and should not have their medical performed.
