EXAMINATIONS ARE REQUIRED AS FOLLOWS:

Persons 15 years of age and over: Physical examination, chest X-Rays and Blood Test. The total cost of the physical examination including X-Rays and Laboratory work is **US \$85.00 or the equivalent in TT dollars.**

Children under 15 years of age: Physical examination. The total cost is **US \$32.00 or the equivalent in TT dollars.**

Important: You must take your passport and immunization records, if available, to the visa panel doctors and radiologist for identification purposes. Please Note: Immunization fees are separate from the physical examination fees.
