SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR IMMIGRANT VISA APPLICANTS**

Visa Processing Times

We are not able to guarantee processing of a visa on the day of application. Applicants from out of town, particularly those from Moldova, should make arrangements for overnight accommodation if necessary. Applicants from Romania may also arrange to have their passports and visas returned by courier.

To speed processing, please send us one photograph for each applicant regardless of age one week in advance of your interview. Write the name of the applicant on the back of the photograph and send them by mail to the following address:

Appointment Procedures

Please arrive promptly at 1:00 p.m. on the day of your appointment. The consular section is not able to accommodate large pieces of luggage.

You should expect to remain in the consular section for up to three to four hours to complete processing of your case. We do not have any food or beverages available other than water, so please bring any food or drink you require, particularly for infants or small children.

Applicants Applying for CR1 and CR2 (Conditional Resident) Visas

An applicant who is applying for a conditional resident visa based on a marriage to a U.S. citizen of less than two years duration should bring to the interview documents demonstrating the marital relationship is bona fide. This can include photographs together, e-mails, letters, or other evidence of communication between the married persons.

Prior Travel to the United States

If you have traveled to the United States previously, please bring your expired passport with the visa (if applicable) as well as evidence of any extensions of stay you requested while in the United States.
