



Instructions for K-1 Visa Applicants

Moscow, Russia

Once ready, the applicant should follow all interview preparation instructions for fiancé (e) visa applicants located on the Embassy's website at <http://russian.moscow.usembassy.gov/fiancee.html>. The instructions contained at the website explain required documentation and procedures to follow prior to the interview date. The applicant may download the necessary forms from the Embassy website.

Upon receipt of the approved I-129F petition from the National Visa Center, the U.S. Embassy in Moscow will send a visa application packet and appointment letter directly to the applicant's home address indicated on the Form I-129F.

Applicants **from Russia may** contact the Embassy's Visa Call Center for additional information at these telephone numbers: 7-495-787-3167, 7-495-974-8843. **These calls will be billed directly to the phone subscriber at \$2.68 per minute with a three-minute minimum.** Callers in the USA or **everywhere else** can contact the Call Center at I-888-222-5673 or 7-495-787-3167, 7-495-974-8843. **Payment is by credit card only.** The cost is \$12 per call, regardless of duration. The Call Center is open Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. (**Moscow** time). Callers should have the applicant's visa case number ready when they call.
