We need a passport to travel to other countries. A passport is a special book that tells other countries who we are. It has our picture and information about us. It also has pages that may be stamped when we enter a different country.



Prepare to Apply

Before we go to the passport agency, we need to gather some important papers, fill out an application, and get our picture taken. We need to bring money to pay for the passport. It's important to have all these things ready before we go.







At the Passport Agency



We will go to a place called the passport agency. When we get there, we might have to wait in line.





We will go through a security check to keep everyone safe. Everything we bring will go through an X-ray machine, and people will walk through a scanner doorway. Uniformed officers will explain what to do.



Checking In



After security, we will check in with a person who checks for our appointment and that our application is ready. We'll receive a number and find a seat in the lobby to wait.





We will wait in the lobby for our number to be called. It may be crowded with other people and possibly loud. We may see and hear numbers being called over the speaker or television screens. We can bring items like books, toys, or headphones with us to help us wait our turn. A restroom is available if needed while we wait.





When our number is called, we will meet a passport worker. The worker will look at our papers and may ask us some questions. We will pay for our passport, and they will give us a receipt.




