IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR CONGRESSIONAL OFFICES

New Consular Fees in Effect on January 1, 2015

On December 31, 2014 the U.S. Department of State will publish a final rule in the *Federal Register* for a new schedule of fees for Consular services. The new fees will be effective January 1, 2015. The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) has approved the new fee schedule that will go into effect on January 1, 2015.

Under the new fee schedule, **visa fees** are set as follows:
