Schedule of Costs for Immigrant Medical Services

The following schedule of costs represents the maximum amount which authorized physicians may charge for a given service. These prices are subject to change only with the approval of the Embassy. If you believe that a panel physician has charged you more than the maximum authorized amount, please inform the Embassy immediately.

<u>Service</u>	<u>Cost (in JD)</u>
Medical Examination (Adult) Includes chest X-ray, urinalysis, blood work, VDRL, and HIV test	85.000/person
Medical Examination (Child) Includes urinalysis, blood work, VDRL, and HIV test	55.000/person
Vaccines	Cost to hospital plus 25% (Note: this is the percentage pre-set by the Jordanian Government for the hospital's profit)
