Applying for a U.S. visa is easy! Forms, requirements, and instructions are all at usvisas.state.gov.



If your flight stops in the United States you may need a U.S. visa. Find out at usvisas.state.gov/visawizard.

TIP

Submit your ESTA application before you fly esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta

Citizens of these countries DO NOT need a U.S. visa to enter the United States for less than 90 days.



Andorra, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Brunei, Chile, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, Portugal, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, and United Kingdom.

Wait times for an interview are short, but schedule your interview early just in case.



You can transit the United States on any kind of U.S. visa. Just make sure your visa is still valid and allows multiple entries.
