SUBJECT: Revised Reciprocity Schedule for China

1. Effective February 18, 2014, in response to reftel, the reciprocity schedule for Chinese nationals is revised for the A-2, C-3, and G-2 nonimmigrant visa (NIV) categories. All other visa validities for nationals of China will remain unchanged. Please note the changes (old figures in parentheses):

- 2. Concerning A-2 visas, temporary duty personnel and their immediate family members now will receive limited validity, sixmonth, two-entry visas. There are no changes for permanently assigned personnel. Such applicants and their immediate family members will continue to receive full validity, 60 month, multiple-entry visas.
- 3. Concerning C-3 visas, temporary duty personnel and their immediate family members will now receive limited validity, sixmonth, two-entry visas. There are no changes for permanently assigned personnel. Such applicants and their immediate family members will continue to receive full validity, 24 month, multiple-entry visas.
- 4. Concerning G-2 visas, representatives of a recognized government and their immediate family members traveling to the United States temporarily to attend meetings of a designated international organization will now receive limited validity, six-month, two-entry visas.
